STUDENTS' RIGHTS	STUDENTS' RESPONSIBILITIES
<p>To attend a school which has a safe, clean playground and learning environment.</p> <p>To attend a school free from bullying.</p> <p>To attend a school which places value on dress code and behaviour.</p>	<p>I have the responsibility to follow playground rules designed to ensure a safe, clean, happy environment.</p> <p>I have the responsibility to keep the school environment free from illegal drugs, tobacco and weapons.</p> <p>I have the responsibility to report bullying and know that it includes physical and verbal harm, deliberately excluding others from a group, ganging up, setting up embarrassing experiences, taking, hiding or damaging others' property.</p> <p>I have the responsibility to always wear correct school uniform when travelling to and from school, at school and on excursions and to behave responsibly at all times by following school rules.</p>
<p>To learn in a classroom free from disruptions.</p>	<p>I have the responsibility to adhere to classroom rules negotiated by the teacher and students in my class.</p> <p>I have the responsibility to comply with the school homework policy.</p>
<p>To travel safely to and from school, on excursions and sporting activities.</p>	<p>I have the responsibility to maintain acceptable standards of behaviour and dress as determined by the school community of parents students and teachers.</p>
<p>To expect positive and respectful relationships.</p>	<p>I have the responsibility to demonstrate mutual respect by being well-mannered. Being well-mannered includes the use of friendly greetings, "please", "thank you", "excuse me", "may I?" and other considerations.</p> <p>I have the responsibility to respond positively to requests from teachers and others in authority such as bus drivers, excursion personnel.</p>
PARENTS' RIGHTS	PARENTS' RESPONSIBILITIES
<p>To be involved in a learning partnership with the teachers and students.</p>	<p>I have the responsibility to ensure that my child attends school regularly and is punctual.</p> <p>I have a responsibility to engage in a partnership with the teachers and students.</p>
<p>To know that my child's learning environment is safe and happy.</p>	<p>I have a responsibility for the basic care of my children.</p> <p>I have a responsibility to support and encourage my children's responsible, safe and courteous behaviour and adherence to school rules.</p> <p>I have a responsibility to be supportive and reflect a positive attitude towards the learning programs provided by the teaching staff.</p>
<p>To be informed of school activities and to be involved in school community decision making.</p>	<p>I have a responsibility to read and respond to communication from the school.</p> <p>I have a responsibility to attend advertised meetings to keep myself informed.</p> <p>I have the responsibility to support the school uniform dress code and ensure my children wear the correct attire.</p>
<p>To be kept informed of my child's progress.</p>	<p>I have a responsibility to attend parent-teacher evenings and parent-teacher interviews.</p> <p>I have a responsibility to give my children responsibilities appropriate to their age and stage of development.</p>
TEACHERS' RIGHTS	TEACHERS' RESPONSIBILITIES
<p>To teach in an environment where the teaching / learning process is respected.</p>	<p>I have a responsibility to maintain a safe, stimulating environment and to provide programs consistent with the curriculum of the Department of Education, appropriate to individual needs.</p>
<p>To work in a climate that is free from disruption, is well ordered, peaceful, safe and non threatening.</p>	<p>I have a responsibility to establish a safe, positive environment which is conducive to learning.</p> <p>I have a responsibility to ensure that correct accident / illness procedure has been followed.</p> <p>I have the responsibility to deal with bullying or reported bullying.</p>
<p>To be respected as a professional by all involved in the teaching / learning process.</p>	<p>I have a responsibility to provide stimulating well prepared lessons and to contribute and take responsibility as a member of a cooperative team.</p>
<p>To expect behaviour from students which contributes to a positive class atmosphere.</p>	<p>I have a responsibility to be caring and well prepared and to resolve, to the best of my ability, problems that occur in the class.</p>
<p>To have the time to work with students as individuals and to be able to deal with individual needs.</p>	<p>I have a responsibility to recognise the rights and needs of students as individuals.</p>
<p>To receive professional support from the school executive and parents.</p>	<p>I have a responsibility to assess my own performance and to participate in professional development</p>
